Attendance Policy / Transportation

June 16-20, school will begin at 8:00 am. Buses will run as usual in the morning and will depart school at 2:30 pm on Monday, at 12:30 pm Tuesday through Thursday, and at 1:00 pm on Friday. Throughout the week all students are expected to be in school. Absences will only be excused upon receipt of written documentation from a doctor confirming illness. In all cases, a parent call concerning illness is absolutely required. Contact Mr. Quimby with questions.

- **Monday, June 16** – Students will meet each class in an A-H eight-period day. Classes will end at 1:25 pm and all students will engage in locker clean-out. Students will be dismissed for the day when their lockers pass an inspection for cleanliness and emptiness; dismissal will be at 2:00 pm. STA bus departs at 2:30 pm
- **Tuesday, June 17 through Friday, June 20** – Students with study hall or lunch the first assessment period may arrive at school at 9:45 for the second assessment period.
- **Tuesday, June 17 through Thursday, June 19** – Students with lunch or study the second assessment period of the day will be allowed to sign out at 9:45 am following their first period assessment **PROVIDED** they bring a **parent signed dismissal note to the Attendance Office upon arrival at school**. STA bus departs at 12:30 pm.
- **Friday, June 20** - Students will be allowed to arrive late or to be dismissed early with an appropriately signed parent note. (If your student has a Block A Assessment, please do not dismiss him/her before 12:30 pm.) At the conclusion of the Block A Assessment period, all students in school will assist staff in classroom cleanout, moving desks and chairs to the hallway and otherwise preparing the school for summer cleaning. As soon as the classroom cleanout task is complete, all students and faculty will enjoy a final barbeque with dismissal planned for 12:30 pm. STA bus departs at 1:00 pm.

Throughout the week students who have lunch or study will have quiet study situations available. Teachers will be available for extra help during lunch and study periods.

Note: Students who choose to arrive to school after a free first period class must arrive on time. Daily schedules and alternative arrival times are posted throughout the building. Students must take full responsibility for their attendance. See Mr. Quimby if you have specific questions.

Dress Code

Dress code is suspended during Final Assessment Week, however, dress must be modest and in good taste.

Hair and facial hair must remain in dress code. Please see handbook guidelines.

Homework

No homework will be assigned during Final Assessment Week other than preparing for Final Assessments. This policy will insure that students will dedicate their study time to Final Assessments. It is important to note that students may have two assessments on one day during the assessment week. Advanced notice has been given in all cases and students should be expected to budget preparation time accordingly. Students are expected to spend the weekend prior to Final Assessment week preparing for all assessments.

Food

Breakfast items will be available in the cafeteria beginning at 7 am. An a la carte lunch menu will be available throughout the day.
