



Medical Documentation

Please remember that the yearly required FamilyID registration (2020-2021 student medical & emergency information) must be completed ASAP!

Required Documents:

- Physical (dated 6/30/19 or newer)
- Immunizations

Required Documents for Specified Illnesses:

- Asthma EAP (emergency action plan)
- Bee Allergy EAP
- Food Allergy EAP
- Diabetes Medical Management Plan/EAP
- Diabetes Quick Reference Emergency Plan
- Seizure EAP

Required for prescribed medication administration (including EPI-PENs):

- Physician/Provider Order for Medication Administration (AKA: medication orders)

Optional Documents (optional, but highly suggested):

- Mutual Sharing

Please note that **all documents must be completed on a yearly basis**, except for the physical and immunizations. Further information below.

Further information on documents:

Physical: Physicals are suggested to be done every year, however due to insurance issues we will allow a physical to be good for **2 years**. **The physical cannot hit the 2 year mark before the end of school. Therefore all physicals for the 2019-2020 school year must be dated 6/30/19 or newer before they can start fall sports or be granted attendance.** The St. Thomas Aquinas Physical Evaluation Form is NOT required to be used. A document from your physician's office will be accepted.

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ST. THOMAS AQUINAS HIGH SCHOOL

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Immunizations: Immunizations must meet the requirements for the State of New Hampshire. Those that are required, and fulfilled, usually cover all 4 years of high school. However, please provide updated documentation if any additional immunizations are required. *St. Thomas Aquinas High School is required to provide the State of New Hampshire with an Immunization Compliance Report annually. Students who do not provide Proof of Immunization/Immunity to the listed diseases to the school are legally ineligible to attend school (public or private) in the State of New Hampshire.* The following is a list of the required immunizations:

Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis: 5 doses of D'TaP, followed by 1 dose of Tdap prior to 7th grade (Tdap should be administered every 5 years thereafter)

Polio: 4 doses of IPV

Hepatitis B: 3 doses of Hep B

Measles, Mumps, and Rubella: 2 doses of MMR

Varicella "Chickenpox": 2 doses of VAR

**The State of Maine is now requiring vaccination to Meningitis. We expect the State of New Hampshire to follow suit in the near future. Talk to your doctor about getting your child vaccinated for this if not already done.

Mutual Sharing: This allows us to communicate with the designated doctor/office in reference to your child records. Such as a physical date, immunizations, illness emergency action plans, etc.
