A scholarship will be awarded to a well-rounded student athlete looking to experience all that St. Thomas Aquinas has to offer. Awarding of the Michael Barr Memorial Scholarship is contingent on certain financial criteria and a completed application. Additionally, applicants are required to submit an essay demonstrating who they are today and what they hope for in the future. Please submit a one-page essay that addresses the following topic: What are you passionate about? What is the one thing that you are most excited to do each day? Our hope is that your response will give the Barr family an honest portrayal of who you are today and what you hope for in the future so that they can feel a sense of connection to the applicant, just as Michael had done with so many people while a student at STA.

Your application will be reviewed by STA to make sure the financial criteria are met and those qualified applications and essays will be provided to Michael Barr's family who will make the final decision.
